 Two boat programs are not eligible for Rain Protection.
- CATERING and BAR SERVICE are additional costs. Catering prices do not include delivery fee or taxes.
- Team Challenge and Ultimate Team Challenge passengers will not be served alcohol until the program is completed. We can run a TAB BAR for celebratory drinks upon request.
 - Each Woodwind is limited to 40 passengers.
 - No outside food, beverages or alcohol are allowed on the Woodwinds
 - No refunds or exchanges unless the Captain cancels the sail due to unsafe weather conditions.
 - All sails leave and return to the Annapolis Waterfront Hotel dock, located at 80 Compromise Street, Annapolis MD 21401 unless otherwise noted.
 - Arrive at least 15 minutes in advance to check in at the Dock Office.
 - All guests must wear soft-soled shoes on board.
 - There is limited paid parking attached to the Hotel. (Yacht Basin Parking.) We do not arrange for parking, we suggest that you use one of the City of Annapolis paid lots. https://annapolisparking.com/parking-locations/garages-and-lots
 - October 2 15: Only one Woodwind is available for private events
 - October 2 -17: All Private Events depart from the Annapolis City Marina (near Carroll's Creek Restaurant)
