ADD-ONS

- **PACKAGED MEALS** can be added from our Catering Menus. **CATERING** and **BAR SERVICE** are additional costs. Catering prices do not include delivery fee or taxes.
- A **TAB BAR** can be added for celebratory drinks after the **Team Challenge** or **Ultimate Team Challenge** is completed. Due to the hands-on nature of the challenge, for the safety of everyone aboard, no passengers can be under the influence of alcohol or other substances
- **TEAM GEAR** is available, including Woodwind hats, t-shirts, sweatshirts and more!
- **RAIN PROTECTION** is available for most single boat Private Charters for an additional fee. Two boat programs are not eligible for Rain Protection. We offer complimentary rain ponchos if needed on all of our cruises.
- Each Woodwind is USCG certified for 48 passengers. Guest count is limited to 40 on Private Charters.
- No outside food, beverages, or alcohol are allowed on the Woodwinds.
- No refund or exchanges unless the Captain cancels the cruise due to unsafe weather conditions.
- All sails depart from and return to the Annapolis Waterfront Hotel dock, located at 80 Compromise Street, Annapolis MD 21401 unless otherwise noted.
- Arrive at least 15 minutes in advance to check in at the Dock Office where you will be directed to your boarding area.
- All guests must wear soft-soled shoes on board.
- There is limited paid parking attached to the Hotel (Yacht Basin Parking). We do not arrange for parking, we suggest that you use one of the City of Annapolis paid lots. <https://annapolisparking.com/parking-locations/garages-and-lots>
- October 1-14: Only one boat is available for private events. Sept 30– Oct 16: All private events depart the Annapolis City Marina.
